The Mall Lights

Further to our communication of December 2nd external electrical contractors have visited and confirmed the findings of our resident electricians. Unfortunately the repair solution will require groundwork excavation to lay a new cable from an existing perimeter road light to The Mall lights. We are awaiting formal quotes from the electrical contractors as they first need to engage with their groundwork sub-contractors. Unfortunately this does mean The Mall lights will not be operational until this work can be carried out which will not be until the new year. In the interim it would be very much appreciated if The Mall residents are willing to leave their porch lights on from dusk till dawn. Your continued patience is appreciated.
